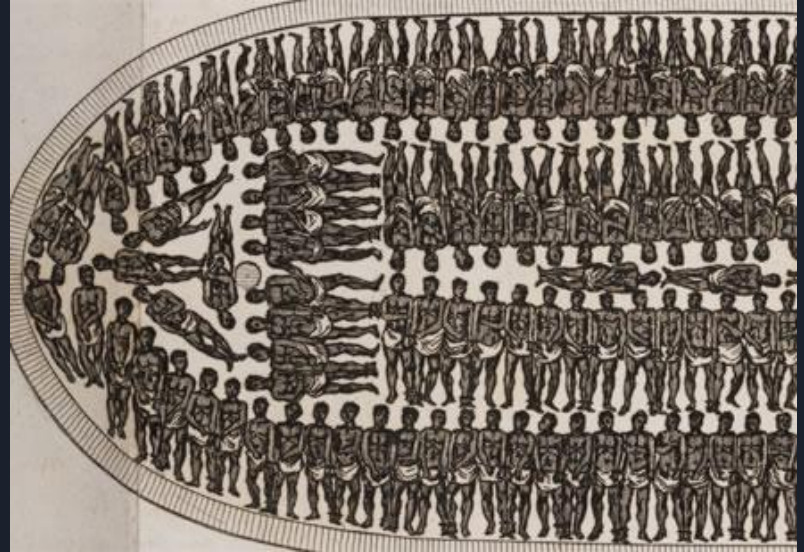
# Before the trade

The Europeans would turn to Africa for slaves who would work freely for them on the plantations.



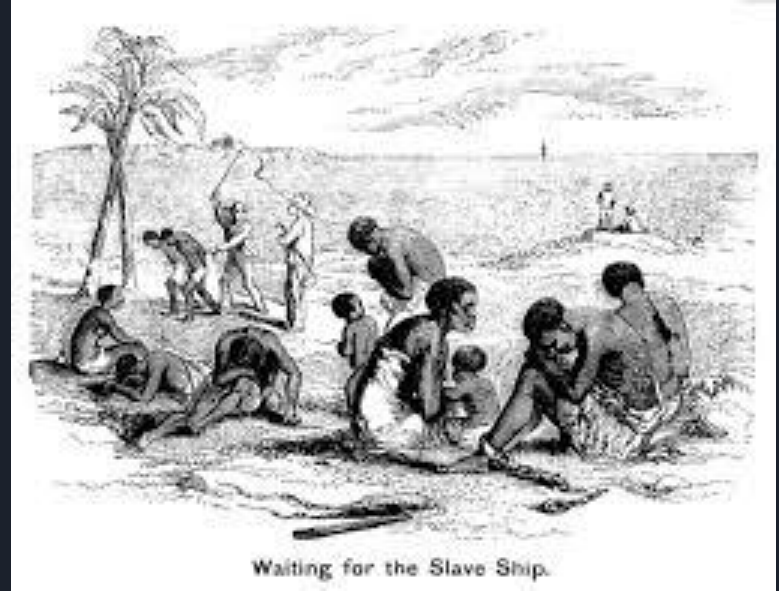
# Brutal conditions
